CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Three** copies of each entry are required please, and these are to be accompanied by one official entry form.
2. The entry form must be signed by the entrant and the entrant's English teacher who must indicate if the entrant qualifies as an E.S.L. student.
3. The closing date for entries is: Friday 21st August 2009.
4. Entries are not to exceed 1000 words (excluding title).
5. The number of words in the entry, excluding the title of the piece, is to be noted at the foot of the entry, e.g. "975 words".
6. All entries must be must be **legible and double line spaced**. It is preferable that entries be typed and submitted as hard copies. Legible double spaced hand written entries are permissible.
7. The work must be original.
8. The entrant's name and the entry's title must be shown in a header on each page.
9. All pages must be numbered.
10. The decision of the judging panel will be final.
11. All entries become the property of the Rotary Club of Richmond Inc.
12. Entries will not be returned.
13. The winning, runner-up and ESL entries will be published in a special Bulletin and on the RCR website, and the winning and runner up entries will be read aloud (not by the student) on Presentation Night. Confidential or embarrassing essays should not be submitted.

Do NOT post your entry. Entries will be collected from each school, by pre-arrangement, by a member of the Rotary Club of Richmond.
